During the upcoming 21<sup>st</sup> ECS conference, the annual student workshop will be dealing with the topics of scientific writing, preparing scientific posters, and giving scientific talks. Furthermore, a discussion on submitting and publishing scientific papers in relevant journals will be offered.

The workshop's aim is to give students guidelines and recommendations on scientific working. During university studies, questions like “How do I write a scientific paper?”, “How do I prepare a poster and a presentation?” or “Where should I publish which results?” are hardly dealt with in detail. However, all students need to know how to deal with these topics as it is crucial for a scientific career.

Four experienced senior scientists will give presentations on the four subjects, and contents will be discussed during the session. In addition to positive and negative examples speakers can present, students will be asked to bring scientific posters, texts or presentation slides they have created recently. These examples can then be discussed and evaluated after the corresponding talk. The number of participants will be restricted to 20.

A summary will be given after the workshop, and for those students who could not participate, this conclusion will be accessible on the ECS student webpage after the conference 2007.
